Demolition/Relocation Investigation & Report (I&R) Application

Pursuant to the City of Sacramento's Planning & Development Code, section 17.604.600, Proposed demolition* or relocation of buildings or structures that are fifty years old or older** – Review for eligibility/nomination for listing on Sacramento Register.

This form is not a demolition/wrecking permit application, nor is it a building move application.

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Application Submittal Components: The applicant is required to provide the following application components for all applications.

- Photos: <u>clear color photos</u>, labeled, minimum size 3" X 5". The photos should include all exterior sides of the structure. Additional photos may be requested by staff (associated structures, house, garage, shed, and neighboring properties).
- Provide a site plan or aerial photo, especially if multiple structures on a parcel, and clearly mark which structure is proposed for demolition or relocation.
- Provide any information available related to the age and history of the structure.

Planning staff will review each application and may require further information from the applicant before deeming the application complete; the 45-day review period begins on the date the application is deemed complete by Staff, including the payment of any required fees.

Use Planning Entitlement Application form when the structure is a nominated or designated Landmark, or a nominated or designated Contributing Resource in a Historic District; or the structure proposed for relocation is proposed to be moved <u>into</u> a Historic District or <u>onto</u> the same parcel as a Landmark;; or the demolition or relocation is being proposed as part of a project involving a Planning Entitlement Application. In those applications, the building or structure's eligibility for listing in the Sacramento or California Registers is reviewed, first, as part of the environmental review for the project for which the planning entitlement application is being submitted. This I&R form would then be used after the completion of the project's environmental review process and the expiration of any reconsideration or appeal period.

NOTES:

* **Demolition** defined as: the complete demolition or partial demolition (aggregate of 50 or more linear feet of exterior wall or more than fifty (50) percent of the footprint of the structure) of a building or structure.

** Age will be based on date the building permit was issued.

*Determinations Expiration: If the structure or building is not nominated by the Preservation Director under this review, the preliminary determinations are applicable for only <u>three (3) years</u> from date the determination is made, or the date the 45-day review period expires after the date the application is deemed complete, whichever applies. Whenever a structure becomes 50 years old, then a new application is required, regardless of its age when this submittal is made.
