

Driveway Visibility Triangle

Keeping vision triangles free of obstruction promotes safety by providing drivers a better view of pedestrians and vehicular traffic while exiting a driveway or approaching a corner. The driveway vision triangle is created by measuring ten feet along the back edge of a public sidewalk from the point where the driveway and sidewalk meet. Connecting these two lines with a diagonal line completes the triangle and forms the driveway vision triangle.
