

Wall and Fence Regulations Near Driveways

Keeping vision triangles free of obstruction promotes safety by providing drivers a better view of pedestrians and vehicular traffic while exiting a driveway or approaching a corner. The vision triangle for a wall or fence is created by measuring ten feet along the back edge of a public sidewalk from the point where the driveway and sidewalk meet. Connecting these two lines with a diagonal line completes the triangle. Within this area, a wall or fence may not exceed four feet in height. (Sacramento City Code 17.620.100, Part C)
