

<p>I am running for re-election because our work is not done yet. District 2 was once referred to as a “food desert”; and now we have 3 grocery stores. While we have significantly increased jobs opportunities, affordable housing, educational opportunities, safer neighborhoods, recreational programs and cultural inclusion, we can do more.</p> <p>I have led the City to increase investments in District 2. In 2019 alone, City investments increased by over 5 million dollars for services that enhance the quality of life for our residents. Many of these new services are aimed at improving traffic safety and flow. A few of the traffic improvements include Rio Linda Bridge replacement and Main Avenue realignment, Bell Avenue Rehabilitation, Rio Linda Blvd and Bell Avenue signal light upgrade, D.W. Babcock Elementary School pedestrian school access improvements, Auburn Boulevard Bridge replacement, and Del Paso Boulevard Street Scape improvements.</p> <p>Finally, I am proposing a compassionate plan for homelessness in the District 2. My plan creates a “Renewal Village.” It will provide for 700 people at different levels in tents, cabins, tiny houses and a transition to single-family homes.</p>
