Three Basic Tips:

Use Your Water Bill and Your Meter to Save Water

Information on your bill can help you manage your water wisely, become aware of water use restrictions and discover leaks. Most water meters have a leak indicator that revolves when a leak is present.

Fix Leaks

An average California home loses approximately 31 gallons of water per day to leaks. Check first for toilet leaks, then heads, irrigation, and finally, pipes.

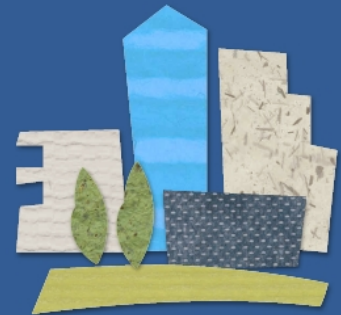
