Free Pet Food



The City’s Pet Food Closet (called “Titanic’s Pantry”) provides free dog and cat food to Sacramento residents in need.

If you’re having a hard time making ends meet and you need food for your dog or cat, just come into the shelter during its open hours and we’ll give you food to help you make it through the month. No proof of income needed.

(Donations of pet food welcome!)

Get Your Pets the Shots They Need to Stay Healthy



A few shots each year will keep your dogs and cats healthy. You can save your pet’s life and avoid expensive vet bills just by getting these shots. Also, the law requires rabies shots for all dogs and cats.

Free Shot Clinic for People on Assistance

If you receive public assistance (Food Stamps/EBT, Medi-Cal, AFDC, WIC, CalWorks, etc), you can get free shots for your pet. Microchips are available for \$10.

When: The third Sunday of each month
Time: 10am – 1pm
Where: City of Sacramento Animal Care Services, 2127 Front Street
What to Bring: Proof you live in the City (driver’s license or a recent SMUD/PGE bill) and proof of public assistance (EBT card, Medi-Cal card, etc.)

\$5 Rabies Shots for All City Residents

When: The first Wednesday of each month
Time: 5:30pm – 7pm
Where: City of Sacramento Animal Care Services, 2127 Front Street

Other Ways the City Can Help You and Your Pets:

Pet tags – Cute and colorful name tags are available at the shelter (while you wait): \$5 or \$7, depending on size. A simple name tag makes it much easier for you to reunite with your lost pet.

Adoptions – Looking for a dog, cat or bunny to add to your family? All shelter pets are behavior-evaluated, fixed, vaccinated and licensed at a great price.
