Rio Linda Boulevard Bridge Replacement Project

City to replace bridge and relieve traffic congestion; Open house planned

The City is hosting an Open House to share information and receive input from the community about the Rio Linda Boulevard Bridge Replacement Project on Wednesday, June 26 from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. at Robla Elementary School, 5200 Marysville Blvd., Sacramento.

This project includes replacing the existing bridge that crosses Magpie Creek just south of Rio Linda Boulevard and Main Avenue; realigning the intersection of Rio Linda Boulevard and Main Avenue to a T-intersection; and adding crosswalks, a traffic signal, and turn lanes from Main Avenue onto Rio Linda Boulevard.

“The project will improve safety, alleviate traffic congestion within the area, and improve access for all modes of transportation,” said Jesse Gothan, Project Manager. “The project is currently in the environmental documentation and design phase. The City’s goal is to maintain community access throughout construction, which we expect will take place between spring and summer months from 2015 to 2016.”

The Open House will include information stations with exhibits, maps, and a project schedule. City staff and members of the project team will be available to answer questions and discuss ideas in an informal format.
