

RESIDENTIAL PARKING UPDATE

ONLINE TEMPORARY PERMITS



Printable 24-hour Temporary permits will be available in mid-September to residents who currently have a valid Vehicle or Visitor Residential permit. Up to 10 permits per month may be used per household. The online portal will be available on www.sacpark.org when this system launches.

This is an optional program. Temporary permits will continue to be available in the Revenue Division or by mail. Forms are available on www.sacpark.org or in the Revenue office (New City Hall 915 I Street).

For larger gatherings, please call 916-264-5011 **within 5 days prior** to the event to request a Parking Enforcement Accommodation, or email ParkingCSR@cityofsacramento.org.

Residents are responsible for notifying their neighbors that an accommodation was requested for their gathering. Re-occurring weekly gatherings are not eligible for this accommodation.

PARKING OPERATING HOURS

Effective September 1, 2016, parking operating hours for metered and non-metered spaces regulated by time limits in all Residential Parking Permit zones within the Central City will have a new operating end time of 10 p.m., as approved by City Council on March 22, 2016. These areas are identified by posted signage reflecting the words, "Except with _ Permit".

During the month of September, informational notices, as opposed to citations, will be issued to vehicles parked past 6 p.m. to serve as a transitional period.



PARKING OPERATING ENDTIMES

Streets from Front Street to the west side of 16th Street, and from Richards Blvd/Railyards to W Street (Area 1):

10 p.m.



Streets from the east side of 16th Street to the east side of 19th Street, and from C Street to W Street, with the exception of Residential Parking Permit zones (Area 2):

8 p.m.



Streets outside of Areas 1 and 2 **will not** have any changes, with the exception of Residential Parking Permit zones:

6 p.m.
