The City of Sacramento is continuing plans to connect more people throughout the city to cycling and walking. The Del Rio Trail is one more step in Sacramento's Bikeway Master Plan.

The proposed 4.5-mile trail will run south through the Meadowview, South Land Park, Freeport Manor, Z'Berg, Land Park and Pocket neighborhoods between Interstate 5 and Freeport Boulevard. The Department of Public Works is excited to kick off the public outreach, environmental clearance and alternatives process.

Offers south Sacramento residents a bicycle and pedestrian route to access William Land Park, the Sacramento Zoo, schools, stores, restaurants, jobs and community parks.

## FUNDING FOR THIS PHASE

The Sacramento City Council approved the project last year. With \$2.2 million in secured project funding, City staff are starting the public outreach and project planning phase. Funding includes federal Active Transportation Program dollars from the Sacramento Area Council of Governments and matching dollars from local transportation funds.
