





Prioritizing air quality and health would mean prioritizing projects that encourage walking, biking, and electric vehicles such as sidewalks, crosswalks, bike lanes, access to transit, or electric vehicle charging

Prioritizing connections to places would mean prioritizing projects that make it easier to reach achools.

Prioritizing equity would mean improving transportation conditions in communities that have not seen

investment historically, lack basic infrastructure, or are low-income communities of color. This could include

aidewalks, prosewalks, bikewaye, maintenance, new pavement, or improved connections to buses and trains.

Prioritizing maintenance would mean fixing potholes, repaying streets and walking/biking paths, and adding


