Sacramento, California, March 27, 2009—If you are mesmerized by anything done with speed, do not miss this weekend's **4th Annual City of Sacramento Sport Stacking Tournament**, which will feature five to twelve-year-olds with some of the fastest hands you have ever seen. This weekend's two-day sport stacking tournament will help crown local champions and finalize the team that will represent Sacramento at the World Sport Stacking Championships this April in Denver.

Sport stacking consists of contestants stacking and unstacking cups in predetermined sequences—the 3-3-3, 3-6-3, and "cycle"—with blazing speed.
