**Department of Parks and Recreation to hold Community Meeting with  
Skateboarders and Dog Owners at Granite Regional Park:  
Saturday, October 20th**

**Sacramento, California, October 12, 2007**—The Sacramento Department of Parks and Recreation will host two community meetings on Saturday, October 20<sup>th</sup> at Granite Regional Park. The meetings will be used to discuss operations at Granite Skate Park and Dog Park and the enhancements that are being made to the two parks.

Designed by a world renowned skate park designer, the skate park has expert-level and novice features, eight bowls—some as deep as fifteen feet, a street course, and great circular flow. The improvements taking place at the skate park include new lights, shade structures, and landscaping.

The Dog Park is one of the best parks in this region. It boasts rich landscaping, trees and shrubs, a dog drinking fountain, and plenty of space. All of these features are located within a gated, off-leash park. The improvements taking place at the dog park include a small dog area, lights, and an expansion of the site.
