**Children, Youth, and Teens with Physical Challenges
Compete at the 23rd Annual A.C.T Games:

Sacramento, California, October 19, 2007—The Department of Parks and Recreation's Access Leisure program invites the media and public to attend the 23rd Annual Ability to Compete Together (A.C.T) Games. The A.C.T Games are this city's premier track and field event for children, youth, and teens with physical challenges. The A.C.T Games are a one day track and field competition open to children and teens ages 3 to 18 with physical challenges. Participants compete in the javelin throw, shot put, discus throw, and a number of race events.
