Sacramento Youth Enjoy Water Adventures at One-of-a-Kind WAVE Camp

Sacramento, California, July 23, 2007—The Department of Parks and Recreation's Access Leisure program, California State University Sacramento (CSUS), Disabled Sports USA - Far West BlazeSports Lake Tahoe program, and United Cerebral Palsy (UCP) invite the media to attend the 8th Annual Water Adventures in Varied Environments (WAVE) Camp. WAVE Camp is an annual camp that allows children with disabilities to enjoy water skiing, kayaking, sailing, fishing, and swimming. WAVE Camp will take place concurrently at three locations from Monday, July 23rd through Wednesday, July 25th.

Twenty-four youth and young adults between the ages of 10 and 25 will participate in the camp. WAVE Camp participants will be housed at CSUS. Swimming and scuba activities will take place at the CSUS pool, water skiing activities will take place at Still Water Ranch, and kayaking, canoeing, sailing, and fishing activities will take place at the CSUS Aquatic Center - Lake Natoma.

Directions: Take 99 North towards Yuba City, turn right on Riego road, turn left on Locust. Look for gate on your right about a ¼ to ½ mile from Riego.

Kayaking, Canoeing, Sailing - CSUS Aquatic Center at Lake Natoma
