**“Cool in the Pool” Program to Provide Added Relief When Outside
Temperatures Reach 100 Degrees Fahrenheit or More**

Sacramento, California, August 30, 2007—As part of its “Cool in the Pool” program, the Department of Parks and Recreation will keep pools open until 7p.m. whenever temperatures reach 100 Degrees Fahrenheit or more.

In line with the normal practice of closing community pools when children and youth return to school, many of the City’s pools are closed this week. Three pools in the north, central, and south areas still remain open:
