Region's fastest sport stacking youth prepare to establish new sport stacking record

Sacramento, California, February 20, 2008—If you are mesmerized by anything done with speed, do not miss this weekend's preeminent sporting event for Sport Stackers, the **3rd Annual City of Sacramento Sport Stacking Tournament**. During this weekend's two-day tournament, five to twelve-year-old youth will attempt to establish a new world record.

Sport stacking consists of contestants stacking and unstacking cups in predetermined sequences—the 3-3-3, 3-6-3, and "cycle"—with blazing speed.

The Department of Parks and Recreation will again be represented by youth in its Sacramento START program, a nationally recognized after-school program that combines homework and tutoring assistance, literacy, and recreation.
