## City of Sacramento Sport Stackers return from World Sport Stacking Championships with **31 Medals**

**Sacramento, California, May 8, 2009**—The City of Sacramento's sport stackers have returned from the World Sport Stacking Championships in Denver with **thirty one (31) medals**. The hard-won medals were earned during individual and team competitions against 700 other stackers from countries as far away as New Zealand.



As in years past, the City of Sacramento was represented by five to twelve-year-old youth who participate in the Department of Parks and Recreation's Sacramento START and 4<sup>th</sup> R programs. Below are some of the medals won by Sacramento youth:

*Team was **undefeated** the entire tournament*

*1st in the head-to-head 3-6-3 Stack*

*1st in the head-to-head Cycle Stack*

*1<sup>st</sup> in the 3-6-3 Stack*

**"Lil' Devils"** (team consisting of 11-year-olds)

*3rd in the head-to-head 3-6-3 Stack*

*3rd in the timed 3-6-3 Stack*
