### **FAMILY LIFE**

Leisure – outings, picnicking, sports, surfing, vacations and hobbies  
Celebrations – parties, weddings, birthdays, festivals, holidays  
Home Life – family portraits, gatherings and meals, cooking, cleaning, gardening  
Children – toys, games and sports  
Homes – houses (interiors and exteriors), apartment buildings

### **COMMUNITY/SOCIAL LIFE**

Social and Cultural Organizations – youth groups like Scouts, women’s clubs, sports teams, dance groups  
Civic and business Organizations – meeting, dinners  
Political Life – organizations, local political activities (meetings, rallies, etc.)  
Schools, Colleges – graduation, special events, classrooms  
Holidays  
Celebrations – parties, dances, parades

### **WORK LIFE**

People at Work, Offices, Businesses, Factories, Agriculture and/or Unions

### **NEIGHBORHOODS**

Buildings – stores, temples, churches, synagogues, theaters, restaurants, schools (interiors and exteriors)

Cemeteries  
Cultural Events – dance and musical performances, art shows, festivals

### **TRANSPORTATION AND COMMUNICATION**

Personal Transportation – automobiles, trucks, carriages, horseback, motorcycles, bicycles
