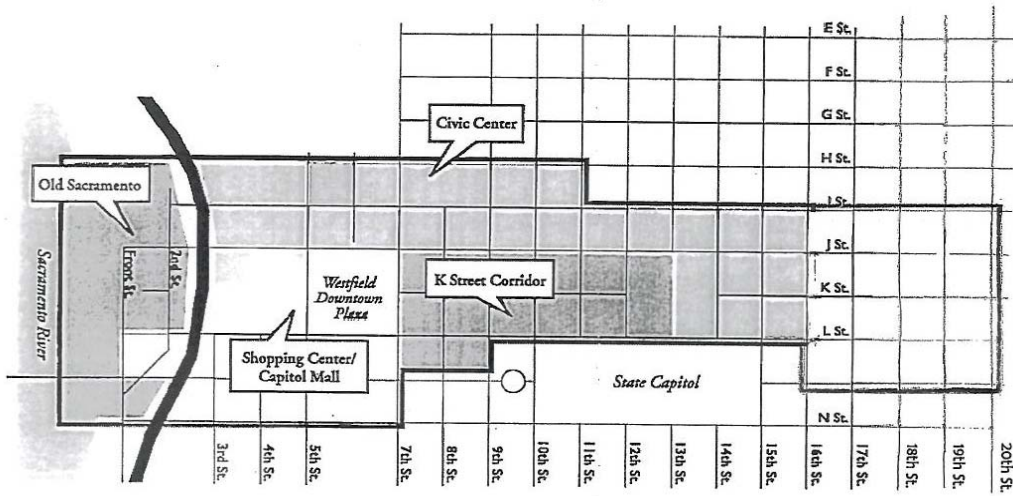
Funding for this program will principally be used to offset costs for providing city services associated with an event. In certain rare cases additional monetary support may also be granted.
