Spring has arrived! At the Marina, we hope our patrons have had the opportunity to enjoy the pleasant weather we've been having lately in Sacramento. We have some exciting news to share as well.

On April 10<sup>th</sup> we will be going to City Council to request that the contract for the South Basin renovation be awarded to Bellingham Marine Industries from Bellingham, Washington. At this time, we are working with Bellingham to confirm a start date and phasing of construction activity, including relocation of boats. As I mentioned in our January newsletter, in-water work (pile driving and dredging) is limited by the permitting agencies to August-October, so while we anticipate construction on E and F docks to begin before then, the bulk of the construction activity will take place during that window. As soon as we have confirmed a start date with the contractor and have a final plan for relocating boats, we will inform all our patrons.

As I mentioned in the January newsletter, we have had several inquiries on how slips will be distributed once the South Basin is complete. Our first task after construction is complete is to relocate current South Basin patrons into their new slips, put patrons that exceed 10% of their slip length into the appropriately-sized slip, and correct any other inconsistencies of berth assignment. Once everyone has a new home, we will begin filling empty slips in the South Basin in the same manner we fill all empty slips in the Marina – by going to the wait list. So if you think you might want to move to the South Basin and have not already done so, please get on a wait list. There is currently no wait list for the new 28 foot and 45 foot slips that will be created in the South Basin. We will not start a wait list for these slips until we are near the end of construction.

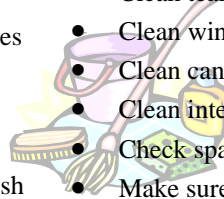

## Spring Cleaning!!

It's that time of year again to get ready for the boating season! Here are some checklists to get you started courtesy of Discover Boating. For more spring time checklists such as electrical, water or head systems, go to their website [www.discoverboating.com](http://www.discoverboating.com) under the tab Owning and Operating:

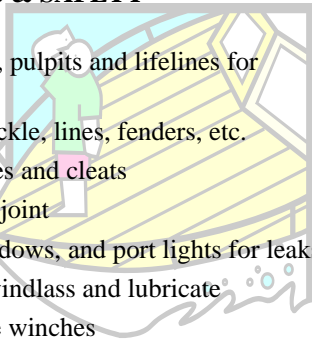
### GENERAL

- Do a general cleaning of hull, deck and topsides using a mild detergent
- Make sure drains and scuppers are clear
- Put on a good coat of wax
- Clean and polish metal with a good metal polish
- Clean teak and oil
- Clean windows and hatches
- Clean canvas, bimini and dodger
- Clean interior including bilges
- Check spare parts and tools and replace as necessary
- Make sure registration is current and onboard



### DECKS, FITTINGS & SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- Check stanchion, pulpits and lifelines for integrity
- Check ground tackle, lines, fenders, etc.
- Check chainplates and cleats
- Check hull/deck joint
- Check deck, windows, and port lights for leaks
- Inspect anchor windlass and lubricate
- Clean and grease winches



### REQUIRED AND RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT

- Sound signaling device
- Check distress signals and expiration date
- Check PFDs
- Inspect life rings and cushions
- Check fire extinguishers and recharge if necessary
- Check and adjust compass
- Check navigation lights
- Check charts and replace as necessary
- Check radar reflector
- Check and replace first aid supplies
