SOUTH BASIN UPDATE

Moffatt & Nichol has submitted the 60% Design Plan which is now available on our website: <http://www.sacramentomarina.com/southbasinprojectupdate>. We also have copies available at the Marina Office if you do not have access to a computer. Project costs have gone up and are estimated to be approximately \$8.9 million due to increased steel costs in the industry and additional items included in the project's scope. We are expecting the 95% Design Plans to be available at the end of May.
