Marina Security Workgroup

A Security Workgroup has been formed consisting of various staff members and boaters. We are hoping to have at least 1 representative from each dock. Docks not being represented at present are D, F, G, H & I. Summary notes regarding previous Security Workgroup meetings are also available from this office.

To date, two meetings have been held.

Issues identified are:

Too many boats being vandalized and/or broken into.

Too many unknown people roaming the docks.

Unauthorized access to the docks, by boat or through the gates.

Gates being left open for guests.

Solutions that the Workgroup proposed:

Larger deposit for extra/lost gate keys

Maximum of two gate keys per patron

Additional lighting - perhaps colored sensor lights on docks

Window Decals on patron's boats

Vehicle Mirror tags as parking permits in the lots

Better signage - posted emergency contact number(s) on every dock

Better control of vendor access to the docks

Camera system on the fuel dock

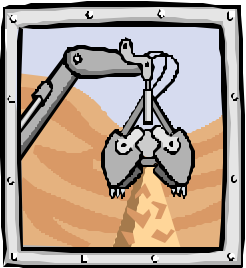
Dock Authorization/Check in Policy

The Sacramento Marina has for years had a Dock Authorization/Check in Policy to help monitor who is on the docks during business hours. We asked that you as patrons, let us know before hand that someone would be coming down to get on your boat. Sometimes we hear from you, a lot of the times we don't. So, we decided it was time to modify the check process.

Effective immediately, we will be implementing an ID Tag system. There will be ID Tags for visitors and vendors. Visitors in the North Basin will be issued Green Tags and the South Basin Visitors will be issued Blue Tags. For the Vendors, the tags will be RED for both basins.

Anytime you have someone who is going to be going to your boat, please have them check in at the office. We will issue the appropriate tag, a key and get pertinent information to be able to contact them if they do not return with the key or tag.

For this to work, we need your help. Please do not let anyone down on the docks that you do not know. Tell them they must check in at the office. If the office is closed, use one of the contact numbers to reach Marina Staff. And above all else, please do not give out your marina key to your vendors. You don't know who else they will give the key to.



South Basin Renovation- Update

On September 30th, 2003 the Sacramento City Council approved staff to apply for the loan from the State Department of Boating & Waterways (DBW). Marina staff submitted the application and DBW conducted a feasibility study and determined the entire project to be financially feasible and on November 14, 2003 the City awarded the first phase of the loan to the Sacramento Marina. Later this month, marina staff will go back to Council to accept the loan from DBW and ratify the Negative Declaration that was prepared as part of the proposed project. Once the first phase of the loan is accepted at Council, staff intend issuing a RFP for the architectural design phase and construction drawings shortly thereafter.



Feral Cat Project Update

As you may have noticed, the feral cat relocation project is underway. Feeding stations are being moved gradually north along the marina towards the end of Broadway. An animal rescue organization will be responsible for managing the feral cat colony, ensuring that the numbers do not increase by altering the cats and taking out any new additions that have been abandoned. The management group will also be responsible for reporting statistical information to the City to monitor it's success.

It is vital for the success of this project that you do not feed the cats. By not leaving food out all night helps eliminate the skunk and raccoon problem we have experienced in the past months. Thank you for you attention and helping this project be a success.
