Prevent Future Crimes by Reporting Current Ones

Bank Stabilization Project

The Army Corps of Engineers and SAFCA (Sacramento Area Flood Control Agency) have identified the need for stream bank protection and restoration for the critical erosion at on the embankment levee on the east side of the Sacramento River 800 feet south of the Miller Park launch ramp. This erosion is posing a direct threat to Sacramento River levee system. In order to restore the levy, they will be doing bank stabilization for approximately 1,800 feet. The construction portion of the project is expected to begin in September and may continue into the early part of November 2004.

- **Off-shore Impacts**

For navigation purposes, please be aware that there will be several work barges anchored in the water just off-shore of the project area at various times during the project. The dredge materials from the Sacramento Marina entrance channel are being considered for use in this project. This may require a barge with a crane to move the silt from Miller Park to the project location. This may impact access through the entrance channel, however more information will be provided as the details of the project are received.

- **On-shore Impacts**

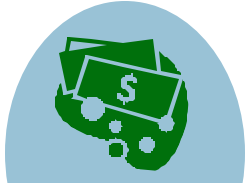
The Marina and Old Sacramento will coordinate getting some of the on-shore traffic through the launch ramp parking area to allow the construction vehicles access to their staging area on the levy along the railroad tracks. Other coordinated efforts include the Railroad Museum to shorten the train ride to stop just before the project area and redirecting bike trail traffic to bypass the fenced off construction zone and staging area.

Skunks

We all know what a smelly inconvenience it is to be sprayed by a skunk. Obviously, the best thing to do is avoid getting sprayed. But how do we cohabitate with them and avoid being sprayed? Incidents reported at the Marina have involved dogs interacting with the skunks, so we've included some helpful tips for dog owners.

- Feed your dog inside or watch to see that all the food is finished and remove bowl.
- Keep your dog inside between dusk to dawn.
- Walk your dog on a leash at all times. Unleashed pets in the Marina are also a violation of city code (12.76.170 Animals in harbor)
- Make sure your dog doesn't stick his/her head into areas in which you cannot see, i.e., bushes.
- Don't surprise them! Take a flashlight with you if you're headed to your car at night. Make noise while walking to your car so that the skunks know you are coming.

Waitlist Clarification

It came to our attention recently that there may be some confusion about how the waitlists work. The Marina maintains 2 wait lists, the General Wait List and the Internal Trade List.

If you're looking for your first slip here or an additional slip you'll want to be on the General Waiting List. There is a \$15 annual charge for each type of slip. Different sizes, basins, and whether the berth is covered will all count as separate lists.

If you're just looking to trade your current slip for something to better suit your needs, then the Internal Trade List is for you! Whatever special requirements you have for a slip, such as being on the shady side or closer to the walkway can be noted on your application, and you'll only be called on slips that fit the description that you indicated on your application.

Whenever you're offered a slip you have 3 days to accept or decline until it is offered to the next person. However, if you refuse 3 slips that meet your criteria you will move to the bottom of the list.

Registration Stickers

We'd like to take this opportunity to remind you to put your current registration stickers on your boat. Also be sure to bring a copy of your registration in to the Admin office if you haven't already.

REMINDER: Berth Fee Increases
