AUTHORIZATION TO BE ON THE DOCK

Please remember to call us as soon as you know that someone is coming to work on your boat or stop by the office to let us know.

EMERGENCY PHONES

We now have emergency phones located at the northwest corner of the K dock and the D dock, closest to D-01. They can be used to contact emergency services or the marina. Please note that you must dial 9 before dialing the desired phone number.

BOATING EDUCATION "Know before you go"
