LIVE PROGRAM FOR BOATERS COMING TO THE BAY AREA!

In an area full of boating enthusiasts it's logical to the Bay have local programming dedicated to the subject. With that in mind, Clear Channel Radio San Francisco launched "The Boat Show" on Sunday, June 25th on Talk 910 KNEW. The show will air on Sundays from 11am to 1pm and will be re-broadcasted Saturday mornings at 6am on KKSF Smooth Jazz 103.7 FM. The interactive show will involve listener calls and e-mails and will cover topics such as safety and regulations, buying and selling, cleaning, maintenance, vacation destinations, marinas, clubs and more for both the sailor and the power boater. The show will be hosted by Michael "Mik" Maguire, Director of Marketing for the Northern California Marine Association, a boating enthusiast since the age of seven who admits he "can't shut-up" when it comes to talking about boats. Maguire said, "From sailing to sport fishing and all that lies between, this show will keep you floating in fact, fiction and fun on the water!" HELP KEEP THE DOCKS CLEAR!

Just a friendly reminder that only certain items can be left on the docks. Every patron is allowed one power cord, one hose, one dock locker and one boarding step. Everything else should be kept on the boat. It is not only important to keep the docks clear to prevent a tripping or fire hazard, but also to keep things neat and to be courteous to your neighbor! Thank you for your cooperation.

APPROVED VENDORS/AUTHORIZATION TO BE ON THE DOCK

As many of you may already know, effective January 1st of this year, any vendor working inside the Sacramento Marina must provide the City with required documentation before performing work on your boats. We must have a copy of their liability insurance naming City of Sacramento Marina as an additional insured and also a copy of their City of Sacramento business license. Please remember to also call the Marina office *prior* to their arriving to get a gate key. Otherwise, they will not be let in and this delays their day as well as the work that needs to get done on your boat! In addition, remember that we do not recommend vendors, they have only been approved to work in the Marina by giving us the required documentation. It is up to you to decide who you would like to hire to work on your boat. This all may seem like a pain just to get your boat washed in the Marina, but keep in mind that this is for your security; anyone who has a gate key has access to your boat!

SOUTH BASIN RENOVATION UPDATE

The South Basin Renovation project is moving along. Plans are almost complete and have been submitted to the City Building Department for permits, as well as being reviewed by the many jurisdictional state and federal agencies.
