SOUTH BASIN RENOVATION PROJECT UPDATE

On September 27th, 2005 the Sacramento City Council approved the South Basin design proposal selected by boaters and staff at the second public meeting held on August 17th, 2005.

The Marina staff are hearing several rumors regarding the 2 foot overhang policy and would like to clarify that the 2 foot overhang policy is still currently in place. There have been suggestions and talk about changing the overhang policy to be 10% of the size of the berth **HOWEVER this has not been done and the current 2 foot overhang policy is still in place.**

What condition is your boat in and does it have the potential to sink? Ask yourself:

- Are you adequately insured or even insured at all?
- If the Marina suffered a power failure for an extended period of time, could your boat withstand the power loss or is it dependent on shore power?
- Can you afford the costs associated with refloating your boat if it sank? Examples of such costs include but are not limited to:
 - Clean-up – absorbent materials and proper disposal thereof \$1,200.00 plus.
 - Towing / hauling if needed – cost depends on distance.
 - Repairs and restoration to boat.
 - Imposed fines from State Dept. Fish & Game of up to \$25,000.00 and Sacramento County Environmental Division of several thousands of dollars.

The two problems the Marina faces when detecting a problematic boat is inaccurate contact information for the owner and the lack of response by the owner. In most cases, incidents can be avoided by remedying the problem. Being proactive and not reactive could save you from these unforeseen costs.

Please update your contact information frequently with the Marina so that we are able to contact you in emergency situations.
