City Launches Online Bill Pay Service

ExpressPay allows customers to make one-time payments for utility bills online with credit card, debit card or bank account.

The City of Sacramento Department of Utilities launches its online bill payment system, ExpressPay. ExpressPay allows customers to make a one-time payment for their utility bills using a Visa or Mastercard or a checking or savings account. ExpressPay can be accessed from the City of Sacramento Department of Utilities' website www.cityofsacramento.org/utilities.

"We are excited to offer this new payment option," said Gary Reents, Director of the City of Sacramento Department of Utilities. "It will allow our customers to make a payment anytime of day, even if our offices are closed. ExpressPay is a great compliment to our other payment options."

ExpressPay is the first online bill payment service offered by the City of Sacramento. The Department of Utilities also offers an AutoPay system which will automatically deduct money from a checking or savings account to pay monthly utility bills.
