## **Impressive Dog Park Is Among Regency Community Park's New Amenities**

**Sacramento, California, February 21, 2008**—Dogs within the City of Sacramento have an additional City-owned dog park they can dream about while on walks with their owner. Earlier this week, Regency Community Park's impressive collection of new amenities—including a 2-acre dog park—were opened for public use.

"It's a great day for dogs, and their human companions," said Councilmember Ray Tretheway. "I invite not just Regency Park dog lovers, but all Sacramento residents, to take their dogs to play in one of Natomas' best parks."

Regency Community Park's new dog park features a large dog area, and a separate, small dog area. The dog park also has a one-of-a-kind dog drinking fountain, sturdy turf, plenty of seating area for dog owners, and a decomposed granite area. The new dog park is the fifth City-owned dog park.

In addition to Regency Community Park's new dog park, the park now has a soccer field where Sacramento's future soccer stars can practice scissor kicks and diving headers. Residents who like to bike or walk can do so on a bike and pedestrian trail that connects the park's new amenities to its previous amenities—a skate park, baseball fields, disc golf course, and fully accessible playground.

Regardless of whether you are a dog owner, soccer player, skateboarder, or parent of an energetic child, Regency Community Park has something to offer you.
