## City Leaders Appoint Interim City Manager

*Edgar and Masuoka Team to Lead City Until Permanent City Manager Position is Filled*

**Sacramento, Calif.** – Last night, the Sacramento City Council voted unanimously to appoint the team of Bill Edgar and Betty Masuoka to lead the City until a permanent City Manager is appointed. Effective April 9, Mr. Edgar will serve as Interim City Manager and Betty Masuoka as Interim Deputy City Manager.

“We’re pleased to be back at City Hall,” Edgar said. “With so much at stake right now for the City of Sacramento, we want to ensure a smooth transition. Our near term priorities are to complete the adoption of the budget process by the beginning of the 2011-12 Fiscal Year, to assist the Mayor and City Council in the recruitment and selection of the next city manager, and to provide departmental oversight during this period of time to ensure that the business of the City is carried out efficiently and effectively.”

Mr. Edgar was with the city from March 1977 to March 1999 in the positions of Assistant City Manager, Executive Director of SHRA and as City Manager from 1993 until his retirement in 1999. Since that time Mr. Edgar has formed his own company and has been working with various local public agencies as well as providing tax preparation and accounting services. Ms. Masuoka was with the City from 1981 through 2004. During her time with the City she held a variety of positions including Finance Director and Assistant City Manager. From 2005-2009 she served as Assistant General Manager at SMUD and in 2010 she assisted the City in evaluating the Arena proposal as submitted by the Convergence Team.
