May 16th Redistricting Map Deadline

Don't miss the deadline to develop and submit plans

Sacramento, Calif. – As part of the redistricting process, the City of Sacramento has developed, free to the public, online tools and resources to create, share, and submit district plans to the City. The tool is available at the City of Sacramento's 2011 Redistricting website www.cityofsacramento.org/redistricting. The community will have until May 16th to develop and submit plans.

Submissions will be reviewed by the Sacramento Redistricting Citizens Advisory Committee and City Council. The community can continue to participate by attending the Committee meetings or Council meetings.

Every 10 years following the U.S. Census, the City of Sacramento is required to redraw the Council District boundaries to balance the population among eight Council Districts. This process of balancing population is referred to as "redistricting." The 2010 U.S. Census total population for the City of Sacramento is 466,488. In order to redistribute the population evenly, the target population for each district is 58,311 residents. By Charter, the Council must adopt final district boundaries within 6 months of the release of Census data; thus, the Council must adopt an ordinance amending the council boundaries no later than September 7th.
