City Residents Encouraged to Apply for Redistricting Citizens Advisory Committee--Deadline Feb 25 *Panel will advise and assist Mayor and City Council of new council boundary map*

Sacramento, Calif. – City residents are encouraged to apply for the Redistricting Citizens Advisory Committee – a newly formed Mayor/City Council panel aimed to assist the public and Council with the creation of a new council boundary map. This 13-member committee is part of the larger redistricting process done every decade to restructure City Council districts. The deadline to apply is Friday, February 25.

“We understand the need to engage our community and obtain their feedback firsthand,” said Cassandra Jennings, assistant city manager. “Community involvement is paramount during this process and this committee is one of the many ways we can ensure that all interests are heard and represented.”

The Mayor and each Councilmember will appoint one member, and the remaining four are selected by the Personnel and Public Employee (P&PE) nomination process. Slated to be a six month endeavor, the role of the committee will serve as an advisory body to the City Council and will represent the diversity of Sacramento. The committee will recommend options and report back to City Council after organizing, analyzing, and refining, as necessary, proposals that meet criteria set forth by the City Charter.

- January: Council Consideration and Approval of the Redistricting Process
- February-March: Community Education on Process
- April: Census Data, Tools, and Community Outreach/Training
- May: Proposals Due to the City
- June-July: Receive and Consider Redistricting Comments and Proposals
- July-August: Council Selection Process
