HEARING ITEMS are items which require Design Review and Preservation Board action as a public hearing and are neither continued nor consent items.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS are items which are presented to the Design Review and Preservation Board for information only and require no formal action.

APPEALS on the Design Review and Preservation Board decision to the Planning Commission and/or City Council must be filed at New City Hall, 915 I Street, 3rd Floor, within ten (10) days after notice of the decision is given. If the 10th day falls on a weekend (Sat. or Sun.) or on a holiday, the appeal may be filed on the following business day.
