SUBJECT: **NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY/INTENT TO ADOPT - DRAFT MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE SHASTA PARK RESERVOIR PROJECT**

The City of Sacramento, Community Development Department, Environmental Planning Services has completed the preparation of a draft Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Shasta Park Reservoir project. Mitigation measures have been identified for biological resources, cultural resources, and noise. The document is now available for a 30-day public review and comment period. The comment period is from **Wednesday, April 13, 2011 through Thursday, May 12, 2011**. You may review a copy of the document at the 300 Richards Boulevard, 3rd Floor reception desk, Sacramento, CA 95811 between the hours of 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday. The project includes the construction, operation and maintenance of a groundwater well and water reservoir on an approximately two-acre parcel east of Bruceville Road and north of Imagination Way in south Sacramento. The reservoir would have a capacity of approximately 4 million gallons. A groundwater well would be installed on the site, with a capacity of 2 million gallons per day, and an anticipated withdrawal of approximately 2 acre-feet per year. A water treatment facility would be constructed with a capacity of 2 million gallons per day, and a pump station with a capacity of 15 million gallons per day. The pump station would pump water from the reservoir to users.

The project site is located on the north side of Imagination Parkway, approximately 1,275 feet west of SR-99 and directly east of the Cosumnes River College's Bruceville Road entrance in the South Sacramento Community Plan area. The site consists of a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 117-0182-023 in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County.
