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FROM THE PRESERVATION DIRECTOR

Since the Preservation Office Staff will be in Riverside next Thursday and Friday for the **California Preservation Conference** – see middle column for the link to the conference’s program – there will not be a **Preservation E-Newsletter** next week.

At the conference, I will be the session leader for a special half-day, pre-conference session on **CEQA 101**, which will have lots of good information on the world of the California Environmental Quality Act and especially how historic resources are treated under the Act and CEQA regulations. There will be a good grounding overview of what CEQA is all about and what all the terms and acronyms are, such as a Neg Dec and DEIR, and the procedures that go with them.

This is a great session with a panel of experts to answer everyone’s preservation questions, from rehab to preservation ordinances, to whatever!
