Weekly E-Newsletter from the City of Sacramento Preservation Staff
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FROM THE PRESERVATION DIRECTOR

This week the [City Council](#) adopted a list of projects to be funded through a major new City bond issue. City Landmarks, including the **Sacramento Memorial Auditorium** and **Sierra 2 Community Center**, and planning for the **Intermodal** project, which includes the **Sacramento Depot**, are on the list for funding.

\$3,053,000 was identified for several projects at Memorial Auditorium, with a matching amount from Downtown bond funding;

\$175,000 was identified for Sierra 2 restroom and access improvements, with a \$600,000 match from another source;

And, \$3,000,000 was identified for various Intermodal Transportation Facility options.

New construction projects, such as the **Crocker** expansion, among many other parks and library projects, were also identified to receive portions of the proposed \$75 million bond issue. Financing is estimated to be completed by June.
