HISTORIC WINDOWS WORKSHOP IN THE WORKS

Tour-goers enjoyed a new-old feature at the Curtis Park Home Tour last Saturday: a hands-on display of historic windows at the 1910 Moses Bungalow. The 96-year-old windows were recently restored by craftsman David Clark, and now slide like butter when they open, but are air, noise, and dust tight when they close.

SCNA, in conjunction with the Sacramento Bungalow Heritage Association, is spearheading an effort to develop a workshop that will teach people how to repair and restore their own windows. The display drew quite an interest, and 65 people have signed up for the workshop so far.
