FROM THE PRESERVATION DIRECTOR

The State Historical Building Code provides for a variety of measures to save original materials, and costs, for "qualified historical buildings." But many in the development community may not realize that Section 100 of the 2005 California Building Energy Efficiency Standards exempts "qualified historic buildings" – Title 24, Part 8.

In recent projects here in Sacramento, this exemption has allowed retention of original historic windows without having to replace the windows to meet regular Title 24 requirements, as well as not requiring certain other insulation additions over original historic interior walls where the regular code would normally require it.

Qualified historical buildings include any listed in the Sacramento, California or National Registers.

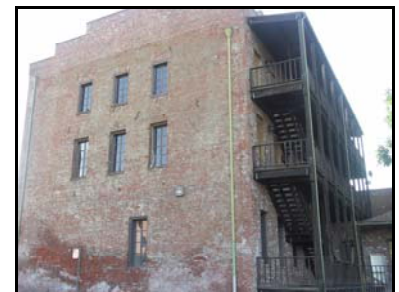
