



CAT VOLUNTEER TRAINING LEVELS AND JOB DESCRIPTION

GREEN LEVEL VOLUNTEER (entry level position)

Cat volunteers who achieve the “Green Star” level of training will provide basic cat “TLC” to our shelter cats, help refresh cages, assist with laundry and dish cleaning, provide basic assistance to customers, handle cats at events and generally support other shelter activities. Volunteers at this level are working on completing the Basic Training (see below) and have volunteered from 0 to 4 months on a regular basis (regular basis means at least 4 hours per month)

SILVER STAR VOLUNTEER (at least 32 hours of volunteering experience)

Cat volunteers who achieve the “Silver Star” level of training will provide all of the above in addition to serving as a “Lead” volunteer in mentoring new volunteers. Volunteers at this level will have completed the Basic Training, Intermediate Training and volunteered for at least 4 months on a regular basis.

GOLD STAR VOLUNTEER (at least 48 hours of volunteering experience)

Cat volunteers who achieve the “Gold Star” level of training may provide all of the above in addition to serving as cat adoption counselors and “Feline Follies” and “Confucius Cat” teachers. Volunteers at this level will have completed Basic, Intermediate and Advanced Training and volunteered for at least 6 months or a minimum of 48 hours.

BASIC TRAINING

Basic training includes: Orientation, General Shelter Training, Feline Follies cat training class and mentoring.

INTERMEDIATE TRAINING

All of the above and completion of the “Confucius Cat” class

ADVANCED TRAINING

All of the above and Cat Adoption Counseling class
