This is to confirm the agreement reached by the City of Sacramento, the Sierra-Sacramento Building and Construction Trades Council and Stationary Engineers, Local 39 regarding the movement of classifications from the Building Trades Unit to the Operations and Maintenance Unit and the General Supervisory Unit.

Specifically, it is agreed as follows:

1. Effective October 1, 2005, the following classifications are placed in the Operations And Maintenance Unit:

 - b. Street Construction Laborer
 - c. Street Construction Laborer Trainee
2. Effective October 1, 2005, the classification of Street Maintenance Supervisor is placed in the General Supervisory Unit.


