Sparrow Park Adds 1.7 Acres of Park Space to Natomas Community

Sacramento, California, March 20, 2007—Sparrow Park, Natomas' newest neighborhood park, is open to the public. Situated on an idyllic, tree-lined street, the park provides an additional 1.7 acres of park space for children and families to enjoy.
