### Hot Weather Preparations

Sacramento area officials are working together in anticipation of an extended period of triple digit weather.

Representatives of the City and County of Sacramento are monitoring the situation closely and want to remind you to take steps in advance to prepare yourself and your family during this hot spell.

A Cooling Center is being opened today at Cal Expo by the Governor's Office of Emergency Services. The Cooling Center will open at 2:00p.m. and close at 8:00p.m. tonight. Starting tomorrow, July 4<sup>th</sup>, the Cooling Center at Cal Expo will open at 11:00a.m and close at 8:00p.m. each day through July 7<sup>th</sup>.

If additional facilities are necessary, information will be made available as soon as possible. At this time we do not anticipate the need for additional facilities within the next 24 to 48 hours.
