**Hart Senior Center to host an awareness seminar for seniors  
who have concerns about the upcoming DTV transition:

**Sacramento, California, February 4, 2009**—Like many other Sacramento seniors, the seniors who utilize the Hart Senior Center's programs and services have endless questions about the upcoming Digital Television (DTV) transition. To answer their questions, the center will host a **free DTV Awareness Seminar for seniors**. The seminar will take place on **Tuesday, February 10<sup>th</sup>**, from **1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.** at the **Hart Senior Center - 915 27<sup>th</sup> Street**.

The impetus for the seminar is the looming February 17<sup>th</sup> transition to DTV and the numerous questions seniors who use the center have been asking. These questions include:

- "I have a digital TV, but no cable, what will happen?"
- "Where do I get the converter box?"
- "When is the deadline? I heard it changed. Did it?"
- "Is my TV going to be clear without the converter box or what?"
- "I bought a converter box several months ago and just tried to turn it on. It doesn't work. Who can I call to help me figure it out?"

These and many other questions will be answered by a representative from the Federal Communications Commission. The Hart Senior Center encourages all seniors with questions about the transition to attend this informative seminar.
