Councilmember Cohn and East Sacramento residents celebrate a community-driven effort that is preserving recreation swim hours at Glenn Hall Pool: Saturday, 2 p.m. – 3 p.m.

Sacramento, California, July 31, 2009—Just weeks ago, Glenn Hall Pool was slated to be closed this summer for recreation swim due to budget cuts. Today the pool has enough funding to remain open for recreation swim.

This much-welcomed development was made possible by Councilmember Cohn, Fremont Presbyterian Church, River Park Neighborhood Association, and many east Sacramento residents who organized a successful carwash fundraiser, made personal donations, and solicited donations from others. To date, these efforts have raised approximately \$18,000, which will help fund the pool's continued operation.
