AGE DETERMINATION

Age category for competition is determined by age as of December 31, 2009. Must be age 50 by 12/31/09 to participate. Age divisions are in five year groups: 50+, 55+, 60+, 65+, 70+, 75+, 80+, 85+ and 90+.

ENTRY GUIDELINES

You may enter any event subject to the entry limitations of that sport. No event can be delayed due to personal schedule. We reserve the right to cancel or combine age groups in an event due to insufficient entries or other conditions. Applications are not considered complete until the liability waiver is signed and dated and submitted with all fees.

DEADLINE

Entries must be received by **Friday, April 17, 2009.**

CONFIRMATION PACKET

You will receive a confirmation packet. In this packet you will receive: Verification of your registration and payment; final event schedule, map to venue, parking pass and other important information.

LATE ENRTY & WALK ON COMPETITORS

Each will be admitted at the discretion of the Series Coordinator. For late entries, Series Coordinator will make every effort to ensure receipt of confirmation packet prior to event. Walk on competitors will be responsible for the cost of parking at the event (approximately \$5) as cost can not be refunded. Shirts for late entrants will be best fit available.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If an event is canceled due to low participation (as determined by the Series Coordinator), participants of that sport will be refunded the entirety of the fees paid.

If an athlete fails to compete in an event for any reason whatsoever including medical injury or event cancellation due to inclement weather, **no refund will be made.**

RULES

Will shoot a 900" round using regulation 48" target. NAA rules apply to the conventional bow shooter. NFAA rules apply to the compound bow shooter (finger & release aid only). *Further modifications may be made by the Series Coordinator.*

EQUIPMENT

ARCHERS MUST HAVE OWN EQUIPMENT- SIX MATCHING ARROWS REQUIRED. Please be sure to mark your personal items and do not leave valuables unattended at venues.

UNIFORMS

No uniform or dress code for this event.

AWARDS

Gold (1st), Silver (2nd), and Bronze (3rd) Medals and ribbons for 4th, 5th and 6th place will be awarded. Medals and ribbons will be presented at the conclusion of entire event. Out of State residents will be awarded medals in order of actual finish and cannot displace California Residents. Your presence is highly encouraged for the presentation of medals. If you are unable to receive your medal after the event, you must make arrangements to pick it up.
