September 3-6, 2010 - Come on down to Old Sacramento during the annual Gold Rush Days Festival, and see the excitement of the 1849 California Gold Rush that started in Sacramento come back to life! This event transforms the Old Sacramento historical district into a scene from the 1850s. The streets are covered with dirt and cars are prohibited from entering the 28-acre Old Sacramento area to preserve the authenticity of the scene.
