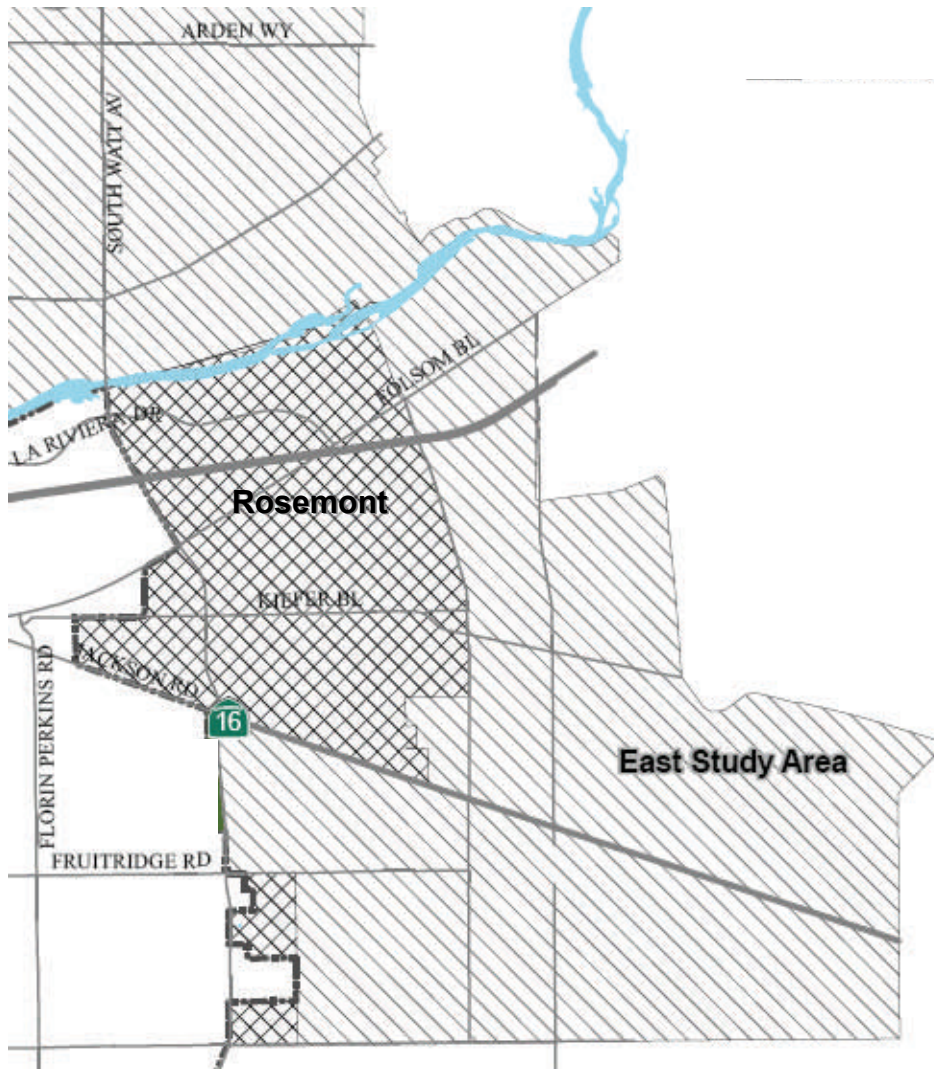


# Rosemont/East Policy Area



The **Rosemont/East Policy Area** consists of 5,980+ acres at the eastern edge of the City between the American River, Bradshaw Road and Elder Creek Road within unincorporated Sacramento County.

The Rosemont area is already within the City's Sphere of Influence but the Sphere needs to be amended to include the East Policy Area.

The East Policy consists of reclaimed gravel extraction pits owned by Teichert and Granite companies. Rosemont consists of predominantly urban residential development.

The City of Sacramento is currently identify opportunity areas within the Rosemont/East Policy Area and policies to be included in the General Plan Update.
