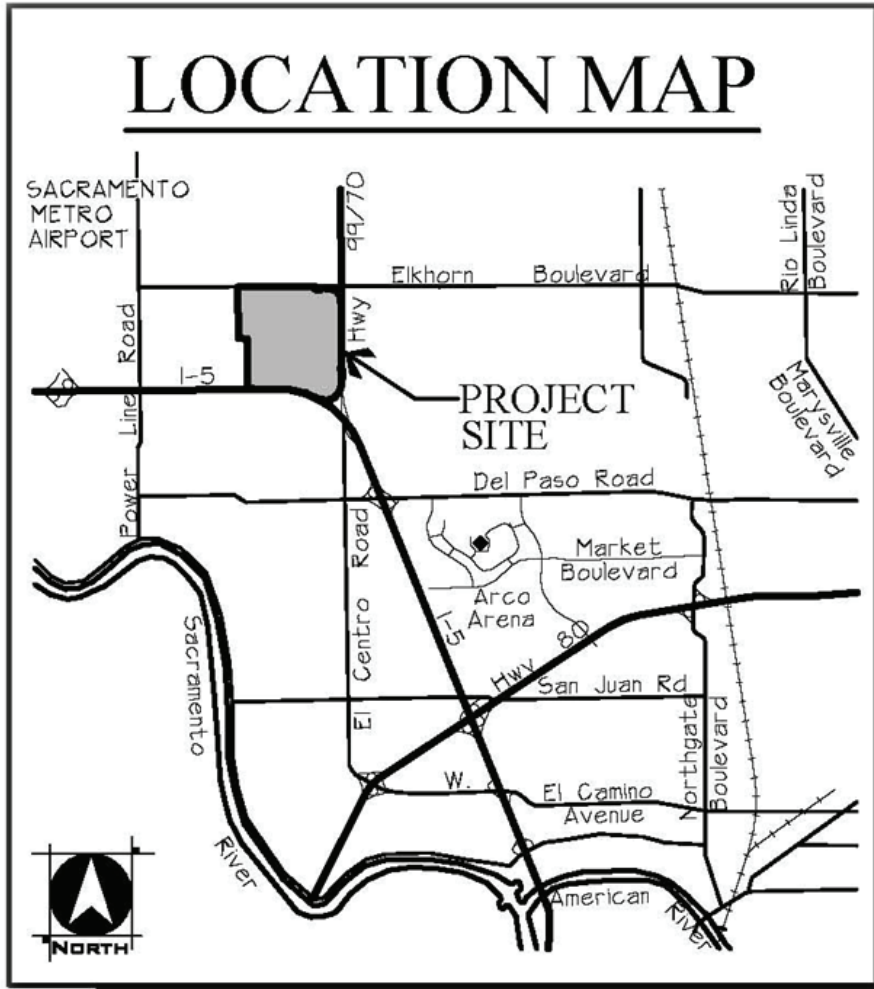


Greenbriar



Greenbriar consists of 577± acres northwest of the intersection of Interstate 5 and Highway 99/70 in unincorporated Sacramento County.

The project required a Sphere of Influence Amendment and an Annexation to the City of Sacramento. These entitlements were approved at City Council on January 29, 2008. The annexation was heard and approved by LAFCo on April 2, 2008, with the effective date of annexation as May 22, 2008.

Prior to approval of any subdivision maps, Greenbriar must prepare a Habitat Conservation Plan. Also, no vertical development is permitted prior to 100-year flood protection for the Natomas Basin—expected in 2011.
