Gladys Cornell, Aim Consulting, welcomed SAC members and observers, reviewed issues discussed in the April 12 Stakeholder Advisory Committee meeting, and reviewed the meeting agenda.

SAC members introduced themselves, including organizational affiliation. Project team members also introduced themselves.

Ron Milam, Fehr & Peers, provided a Purpose and Need Statement overview and described its role in the River Crossings Study. Gladys Cornell then facilitated a SAC discussion on issues for consideration in development of the Purpose and Need Statement.

Following a brief break, Ron Milam and Gladys Cornell provided an overview of issues to be considered in evaluating river crossing opportunities and constraints. Gladys Cornell then facilitated an exercise through which SAC members identified specific opportunities and constraints on project-area maps.

Ron Milam presented an initial draft of river crossing evaluation criteria and requested that SAC members review the material and be prepared to provide specific feedback at the July 12 SAC meeting.

Gladys Cornell described work to develop an on-line stakeholder survey, which will be made available to the SAC and other stakeholders in early June. SAC members will be expected to help with communications to their represented organizations and others about the survey's availability.

Gene Endicott provided an update on the June 14 bus tour of the project area. Current plans are that the Yolo County Transportation District will provide a 57-passenger bus for the tour, which is scheduled for 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. Details will be provided to the SAC as soon as they are available. The site tour will replace the previously scheduled SAC meeting for June 14.
