12th & 13th Streets Water Transmission Main

The 12th and 13th Streets Water Transmission Main Project will replace riveted steel water pipelines constructed in 1915.



Why is the City replacing the water transmission main?

Over time old pipes corrode and require replacement. The Department has systematically replaced a large portion of the 63,300 feet of riveted steel pipelines. The new project will help ensure a reliable water supply to the City of Sacramento and reduce the potential for property damage due to water main breaks.

Where will the new transmission main be placed?

The new 24-inch water main will follow the existing alignment on 12th Street from H Street to L Street, proceed down L Street to 13th Street and down 13th Street to Q Street. The project also installs new fire hydrants and small distribution water mains in the general area. Typical hours of construction will be 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
