

Self-Certification of Compliance with Water Conserving Fixture Requirements

As of January 1, 2014 a new State Law went into effect and applies to all single family residences built before January 1, 1994. This legislation requires water conserving plumbing fixtures be installed throughout the home as a condition of building permits applied for after January 1, 2014.

This signed self-certification may be used in lieu of a city building inspector verifying compliance with this water conserving fixture requirement for areas of the residence **not** included in the scope of work of the issued permit.

The water conservation requirements are:

- All toilets use no more than 1.6 gallons of water per flush
- All showerheads flow no more than 2.5 gallons of water per minute
- All interior faucets emit no more than 2.2 gallons of water per minute
